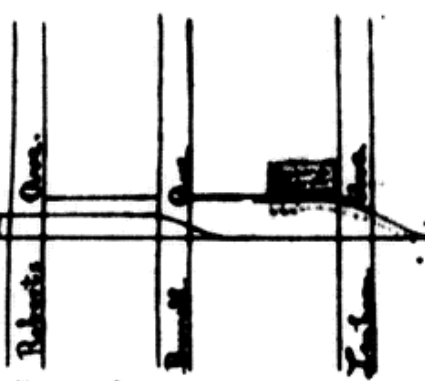

I respectfully recommend the improvement described below, and request special appropriation to cover cost of same:

1. Location (with regard to nearest station) Cooperstown East head block 600 ft south of H.B. to house track.
2. Title. (Side Tracks and Spurs to be named) Cooper's elevator spur, 600 feet
3. Description. (Give description of proposed New Work. If siding or spur, make sketch below showing Points of Compass; if Standard Building, no description is necessary, but give Plan No.)



4. New Work, Additions or Repairs. NEW WORK
5. Necessity for proposed Work: (If increase of Business, give particulars.)  
To furnish track facilities for new elevator to be constructed by R. C. Cooper.
6. Is Improvement on Right-of-way or Land owned by this Company? Not entirely  
If not, what can be done to secure Title? Mr. Cooper will secure easement covering occupation of street and will furnish easement covering the portion of track to be located on his land.
7. Estimate of Cost: Material (as itemized on next page) \$325.00 Labor \$65.00 Total \$390.00
8. Work should be commenced at once in order to complete for this season's business and to facilitate handling material for new elevator.
9. Length of Time required to complete Work One week
10. Remarks: (Note here if any Material or Labor is to be furnished by outside parties, and whether work should be done by contract or with Company force.)
