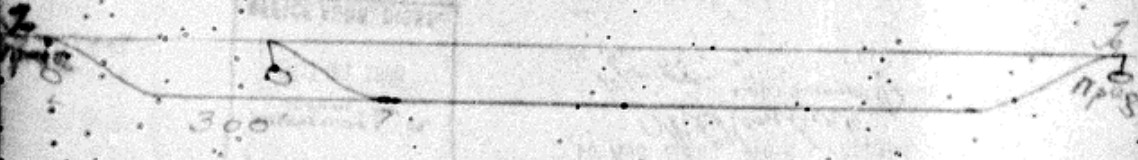

- 1. Location (with regard to nearest station) **West East head block ft. West of M. P.**
- 2. Title (Wide Tracks and Spurs to be named) **Extension siding**

Extension West siding 300 ft on east end.



- 4. New Work, Additions or Repairs **Addition.**

To provide track room for Farmers' Elevator.

- 6. Is Improvement on Right-of-way or Land owned by this Company? **Yes.**

8. Work should be commenced **at once** in order to **give farmers a chance to do grading while not busy.**
