Title and Reason: **Replace arc lights in the two freight houses with 300-watt Mazda lamps.**

The two freight houses at Seattle are lighted by 42 arc lights owned and maintained by the Puget Sound Light & Power Co. The contract under which the lights were furnished expired last December, and the new contract does not provide that the Power Company will furnish or maintain lamps. They have requested us to return the lamps, which are obsolete. It will be necessary, therefore, to replace these arc lights with 42 300-watt Mazda lamps. With the change in lamps there will be a saving in current amounting to about \$150. per annum.

The 300 watt lamps will be furnished by the Truck Owners Terminal, the balance of the expense to be borne by the Railway Company.

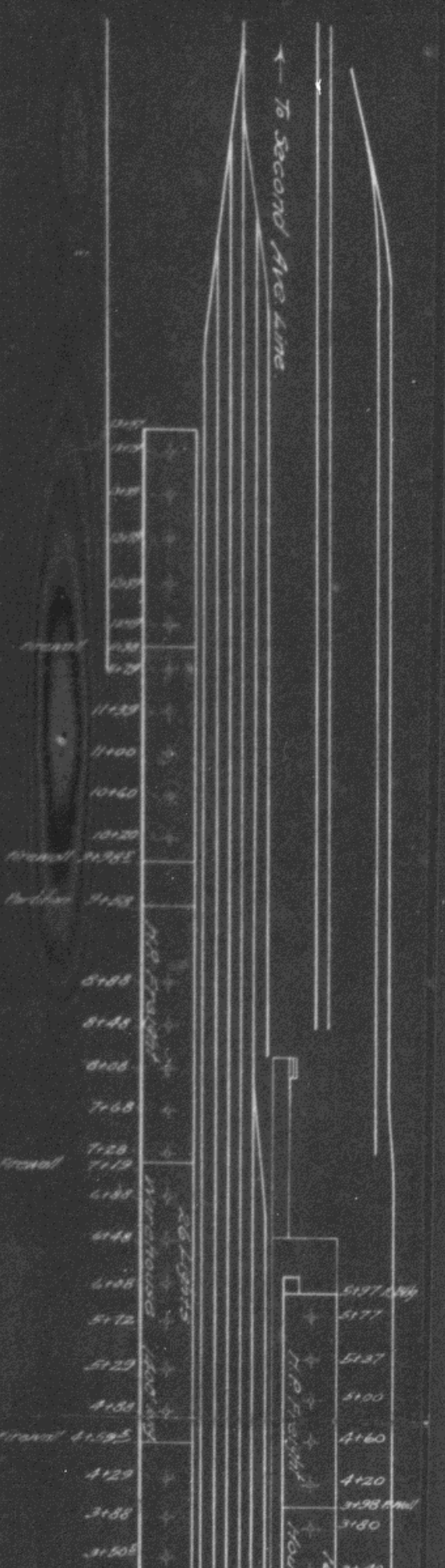
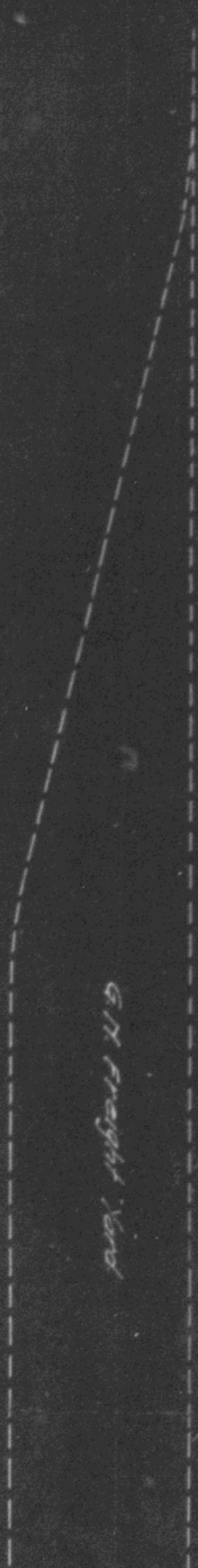
