It is therefore recommended we move this tool house from Crookston to Grand Forks, and fix it up as oil house.

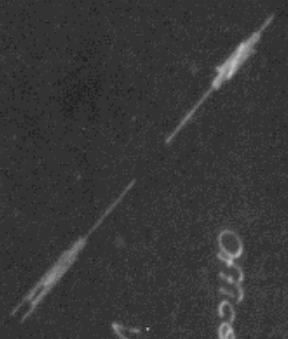
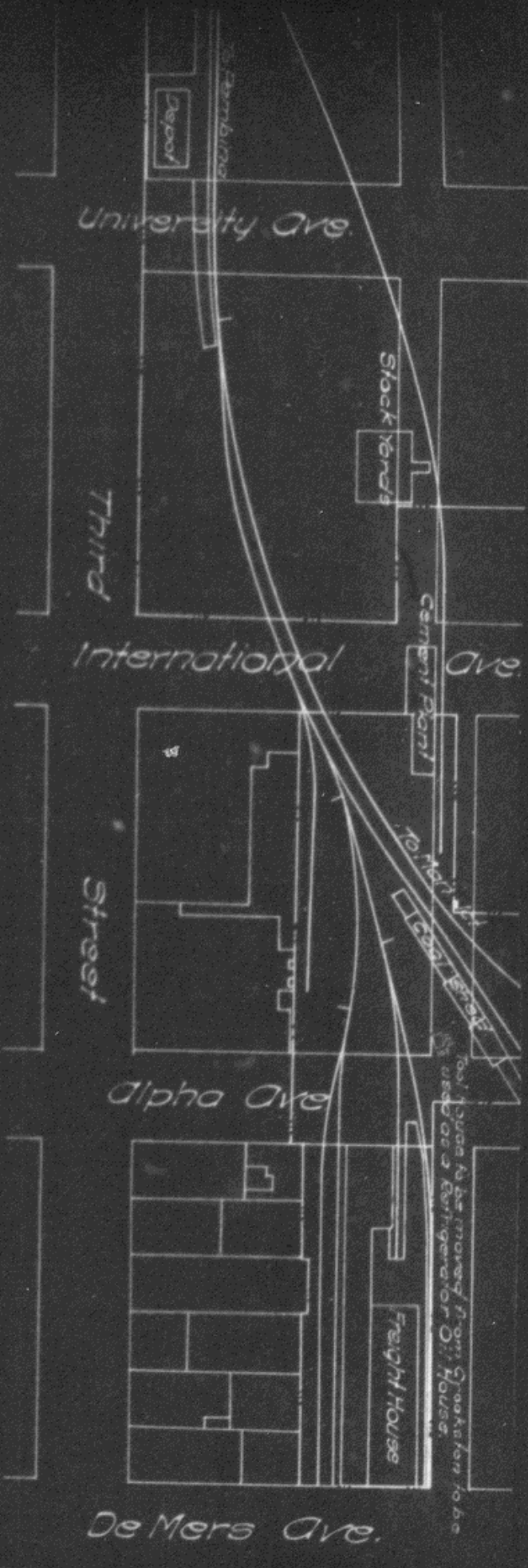
