Title and

Reason: Before paving the Inland Empire highway between these two points the State of Washington relocated the highway to parallel our tracks in order to save distance, curvature and grade. Our right of way between Buena and Dalton is generally fifty feet wide so that in building the highway parallel with and contiguous to the fifty foot right of way it is not less than twenty-five feet from center line of our track at any point. The land given up under the easement is only at the few points where the right of way is of greater width than twenty-five feet from center line of track and all operating officers agreed there was no objection to granting the easement.

Easement deed to the State of Washington was executed by Mr. Donnelly November 28, 1921. The cost of the land sold cannot be accurately determined. Portions of it were acquired under various small area purchases at prices ranging from \$500 to \$2500 per acre according to the improvements on the land. For accounting purposes the cost of the land disposed of is \$1500.
