Location: Alameda

Title and Reason: Box car body fitted up for use of switchmen. At Alameda on Santa Fe Branch there are two switchmen three switchmen were employed working under existing CHASER and Marsh's Receipts. It is necessary to provide shelter where men in winter can dry their clothing, and also keep their lanterns, etc. A car is temporarily used for at the present time by use of an old car shunted out of rails. In order to take care of the situation permanently, it is proposed to fit up a box car body to be set off on the ground provided with lockers, etc. and this is recommended as per sketch and estimate herewith attached.

Estimate of cost of providing a box car body, fitted up for use of switchman, at Aberdeen, as per sketch dated Dec. 31, 1921.

Three switch crews operate at Aberdeen. Switchmen have no present facilities for cleaning lanterns. No provisions have been made for the drying of clothing, and Aberdeen is in a particularly wet country.

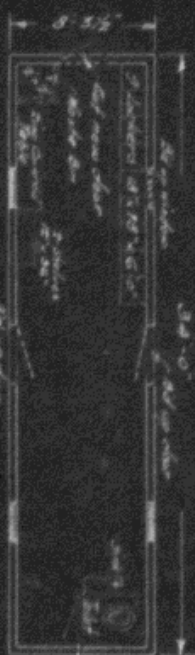
EPK ED 172 was submitted in May 1920 for a switchman's shanty and oil house. This was not approved but the disapproval carried the suggestion of fitting up a box car body to serve the purpose until a more favorable time.

The suggestion was not acted upon. Instead an outfit car on wheels was spurred out. Being in joint territory rental was charged the O.&W. and CR&St.P. for their proportion. Bills for back rental, amounting to about \$600.00, will shortly be submitted, and there is no doubt but that the tenant lines will protest.

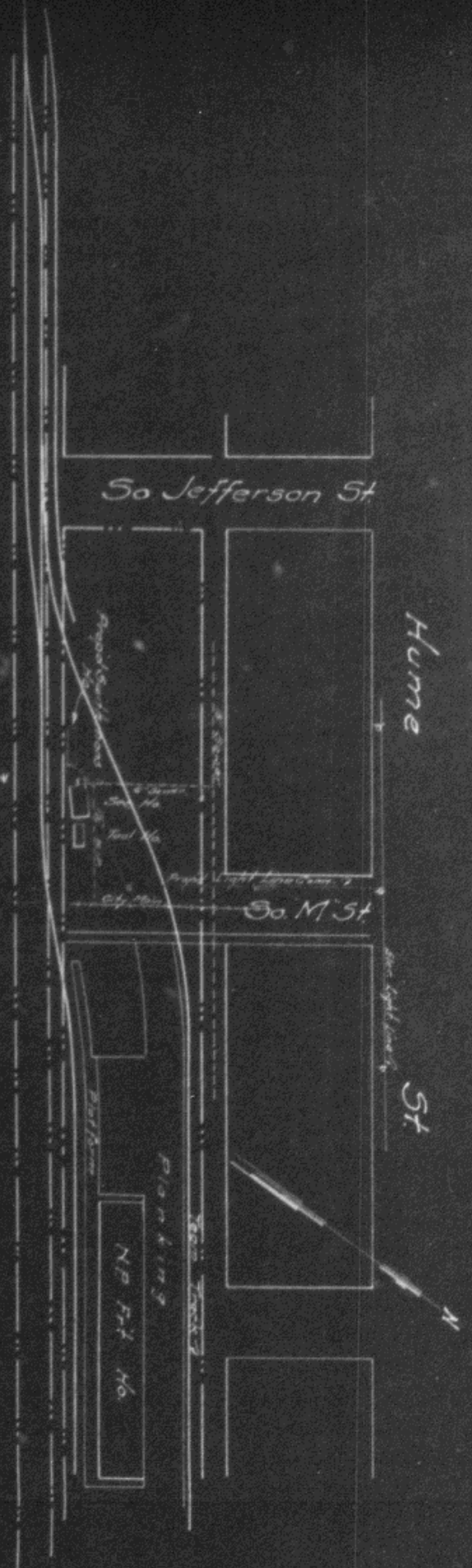
It is proposed to fit up a box car body with a toilet, lockers and a place to clean lanterns.
